

Winding Bobbins—Entering Weft

Tips:

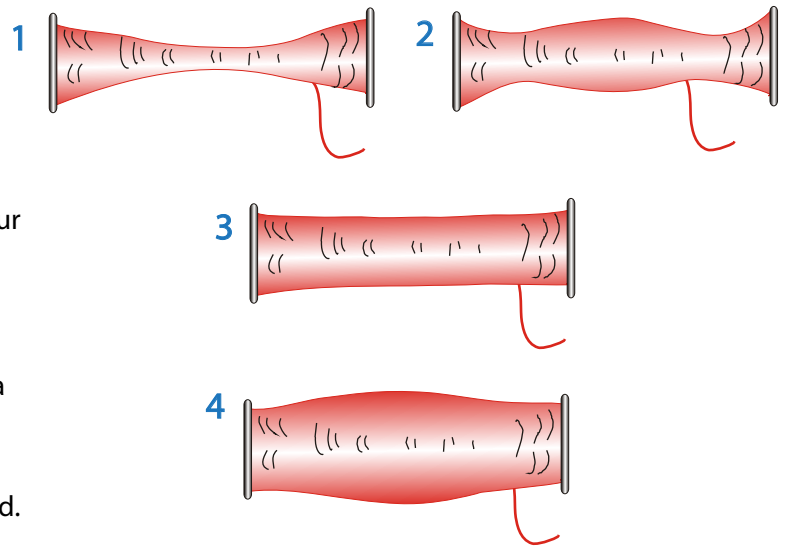
- ▶ At the start, wind a few bobbins so that you can weave uninterrupted.
- ▶ Leave the selvages alone!

Winding bobbins

Place the bobbin on the winder, anchor the weft yarn by turning the bobbin it a few times using your fingers. (Be sure to go in the direction you will be winding.)

- 1 While winding lead the yarn back and forth building up the weft at each end. Try to keep a **EVEN** tension on the yarn.
- 2 Continue carrying the yarn back and forth across the center and up the ends already filled.
- 3 Fill in the center of the bobbin until the yarn lies in a straight line from end to end.
- 4 Continue winding until the bobbin is filled (slightly concave).

When full, remove the bobbin and slip it onto the bar of the shuttle. The weft comes from the underneath the bobbin and is threaded through the shuttle hole (bobbin moves in a clockwise direction).
